Daily Rundown:

Day	Date	Scripture Focus	Prayer Focus
1	Jan 9	No video today	Sunday worship
2	Jan 10	Psalm 51: David's prayer of confession	Confession requires us to be honest before God and ourselves. What are some areas of your life you need to confess to God? Ask God to reveal those to you.
3	Jan 11	Jonah 2:1-9: Jonah's prayer after he fled from God	God hears us even when we are in our deepest darkest moments. If you are in a deep and dark place, spend some time crying out to God, trusting that He hears. If not, spend some time praising Him for how He has delivered you from those moments in the past
4	Jan 12	Colossians 1:9-14: Paul's seven-fold blessing	Paul prays several things over the people who made up the church at Colossae. Which of these things do you need today? Knowledge? Wisdom? Understanding? Strength? Endurance? Boldly ask God to pour that out on you today.
5	Jan 13	2 Thessalonians 1:11-12: Paul's prayer for the Thessalonians	Paul prays that the Thessalonians would be "worthy of God's calling" and would live up to all that He has planned for them so that Jesus may be glorified in them. How are you fulfilling God's call on your life and bringing Him glory?

6	Jan 14	Hebrews 13:20-21: A prayer of equipping	God allows us to experience His goodness so that we will be equipped to do His will. Ask Him to equip you today for the work He wants to do in and through you.
7	Jan 15	No video today	Saturday live gathering
8	Jan 16	No video today	Sunday worship
9	Jan 17	Luke 22:31-32: Jesus' prayers for Peter	Jesus prayed for Peter's faith to be strong and for him to be an encouragement to the brothers. He knew Peter would be tempted and would need strong faith. Are we praying for the people in our churches to have strong faith amidst temptations and to be an encouragement to those around them?
10	Jan 18	Acts 4:23-31: The church's prayer for boldness	The early church deeply desired boldness in speaking the word of God. Pray that our local churches would have this same desire, and that we would have extraordinary courage every time we speak God's word, even in the midst of opposition.
11	Jan 19	Romans 15:5-7: Paul's prayer for harmony	Paul recognized that the church living in peace was necessary for the gospel of Christ to be clearly heard. Pray against division in our churches, so that "with one voice" God would be glorified and His glory made more known
12	Jan 20	2 Corinthians 13:11-14: Paul's prayer for restoration and comfort	When the church lives at peace with each other, it is able to experience and extend restoration and comfort. Pray that our churches would be restored where there is brokenness so we can extend comfort to those around us
13	Jan 21	Acts 13:1-4: Praying over Saul and Barnabas before they were sent	The early church recognized that it was important to not only send people out, but to pray over them before they went. Pray that the Holy Spirit would call out people in our own church community and that we would be faithful in sending them out.
14	Jan 22	No video today	Saturday live gathering
15	Jan 23	No video today	Sunday worship
16	Jan 24	Matthew 14:13-21: Jesus' prayer over the loaves & fish	Jesus prayed a blessing over the food, but this was also a prayer of multiplication. Pray that God would multiply His church through new church plants, new faith communities, and new believers.
17	Jan 25	Romans 1:8-12: Paul's prayers to return to the church at Rome	Paul loved this church and desired to be back with them, even though he was currently physically separated from them. What sister churches are we loving, thanking God for, praying over, encouraging, and strengthening?

18	Jan 26	Ephesians 3:14-21: Paul's prayer for all generations	Paul prays all these things over the church "throughout all generations". Spend some time praying that God would receive glory not just in this generation, but in the next generation and the one after that. Specifically pray that the next generation would be a change force for the gospel around the world
19	Jan 27	2 Kings 19:15-19: Hezekiah's prayer for deliverance	Hezekiah is asking God to deliver his people "so that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you alone, Lord, are God." Pray that in the midst of opposition, God's power would be seen in our nation and all nations of the world
20	Jan 28	Revelation 7:9-12: Prayer of the multitude from every nation	Pray that we would begin to see this heavenly reality on earth, as people from every nation and people group come to know Jesus!
21	Jan 29	No video today	Saturday live gathering

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS:

Week One	Psalm 32 (esp. vs 5-7): A psalm of blessing for the forgiven	When we acknowledge our sin to God, He is faithful to forgive us. Thank God for the ways He has forgiven, whether recently or throughout your life
Week Two	Acts 1:12-14, 2:1-4: The church prays and receives the Holy Spirit	One of the first things the early church fathers did was pray together "in one accord". This is where the Holy Spirit came upon them. Pray that our churches would have a singular focus on prayer, and ask the Holy Spirit to fill our churches with a fresh wind of God's power
Week Three	John 17 (esp. vs 20-24): Jesus' prayer for future believers	In praying for those "who will believe in me", Jesus is praying for future believers, including us. Pray that we would live unified so that the world would know who Jesus is and would experience His love through us.
